Season Dates and Hours

Starboard Swim Club opens Friday, May 25th (Memorial Day Weekend) and closes Monday, September 3rd, 2018 (Labor Day). Saturdays will be open through September, weather dependent.

10am - 10:00pm (Pool Closes at 7:00 PM to minors)
The facility closes to all at 8:00 pm on weekdays and 10:00 pm Fri,
Sat & Sun.

Ocean Lifeguard on duty as per city ordinance.

Starboard Swim Club is a non-smoking facility (this includes cigarettes, pipes, cigars and electronic cigarettes).

Reservations and Services

Towels

Starboard Swim Club offers unlimited towel service to all of our members and guests. Please be courteous and take only the number of towels needed.

Cabanas

Cabana rentals will be on a first come, first served basis. Premium members may reserve cabanas within one week of scheduled date. Basic package and Single package members can reserve a cabana within a 24-hour period. Prices may vary. Please inquire within.

Lockers

All Premium members will receive a dedicated locker for the season. Basic and Single members can obtain a locker on a first come, first served basis.

Purchases

All food, beverage and retail purchases can be made using the bracelet provided to each member at the beginning of the season. This bracelet will be synced to a credit card on file. Guests who wish to use cash for purchases will need to provide a card on file at the start of the day and will have the option to close out with cash. If members or guests fail to close out, Starboard Swim Club will charge the card on file at the start of business day the following day.

Parking

Public parking is provided within walking distance to the pier. Parking is found on a first come, first served basis.

Lost and Found

Starboard Swim Club is not responsible for any lost, left or stolen items. Employees will take all unattended items to the management office for safe keeping. Lost and Found items will be disposed of at the end of the season.

Rules and Regulations

- 1. All rules and requests made by lifesaving personnel and Pool Manager must be followed.
- Children under 7 years old, or less than four feet tall, must be
 accompanied by a parent or responsible person in a swim suit at all
 times including in the water, on the deck and in the restroom. While in
 the water, the parent/responsible person must remain within arm's
 reach at all times.
- 3. All children under the age of 4 years old must wear a swimsuit diaper or plastic pants and a swim suit regardless of toilet training. No cloth or disposable diapers are allowed. Diaper changing may only take place in

- the bathrooms. Parents must report any accidents to the lifeguards immediately.
- 4. Persons in and around the water must wear acceptable swim suits. Please refer to city ordinance documentation for acceptable public apparel.
- 5. Animals are not allowed in the building or pool area, with the exception of guide/service dogs. Guide/service dogs are allowed on deck, but not in the water.
- 6. Persons under the influence of alcohol or narcotics will be denied admission and/or asked to leave the premises. No refunds will be made.
- 7. No outside food or beverages are allowed on premises. No glass items, chewing gum or smoking is permitted in the facility.
- 8. Toys and flotation devices are not allowed unless part of organized activity, for child safety, or approved by the Pool Manager.
- 9. All patrons coming from the beach must shower before entering the pool. Persons with open cuts, sores, bandages, colds, coughs or infected eyes are not permitted in the pool.
- 10. Spitting, spouting or nose-blowing in the pool is strictly prohibited.
- 11. Lying on the deck close to the edge of the pool where swimmers may trip over sunbathers is dangerous. Sunbathers must lie or sit at least three (3) feet away from the edge of the pool or in a designated area for such activity.
- 12. Dangerous practices are prohibited. Patrons must not run on decks; climb, sit or jump from fences; dunk, push, pull or splash swimmers. Jumps are permitted feet first. Back jumps, twisting and flips are not permitted at any time. Patrons must obey lifeguards at all times.
- 13. Strictly no diving, back dives, somersaults, cannon balls from the side of the pool or any jumping into the water in any way.
- 14. Do not engage active lifeguard in unnecessary conversation.

- 15. Emergency procedures must be observed. Swimmers must leave the pool area immediately upon the signal or request of the Pool Manager or lifeguard.
- 16. Foul or abusive language will not be tolerated.
- 17. Any injuries occurring on property must be reported to the Pool Manager and a written report must be filed.
- 18. Please be courteous to one another and pick up after yourselves and your children. Please do not save seats. Table and chairs are for those currently using the facilities.
- 19. Starboard Swim Club reserves the right to change rules, regulate operating hours, enact new rules, or otherwise make changes to this document at any time.

Applications

Deposits

1/3 of the full deposit is due immediately to secure your membership. The remaining 2/3 is due no later than June 1, 2018.

Membership Packages

Starboard Swim Club has three membership packages: Premium, Basic and Single. All members applying for a Premium package must be approved. See Membership Packages attachment for membership inclusions and terms.

Membership is strictly non-transferrable. The guest names submitted during the application process is the only guest allowed use of the club. Starboard Swim Club defines Adult as members 21 years of age or older, and minors as under 21 years of age.

Guests

Guest passes may be obtained for Residential and Seasonal members on a per day basis at \$20 and \$30, respectively. **One guest pass per one person.**

Limit of 4 guests are permitted per membership at one time unless prior permission from the Pool Manager is granted. If a member would like to bring more than 4 guests, they may speak with our event coordinator in advance to book a group event.

Guests must be accompanied by a member and will be required to sign in and provide current identification.

Member is responsible for the behavior of all of their guests.

Adult guests are limited to 4 weekend visits per season.

Fees

There will be a \$50 charge for every fob that needs to be replaced due to it being lost, stolen, or damaged.
